

You, Yew and Ewe Are Homonyms, Too
Lesson Plan
Grades 2-3-4

Vocabulary

Homonym: word with the same sound but with a different meaning

Lesson

Materials: crown pattern (needs to be glued at middle), construction paper, markers

Teacher should write one homonym on each crown before the lesson.

Lesson:

After reading the book together, pass out a prepared homonym crown to each student. Have the students put on their crowns and stand in a circle. When the teacher says GO, students must find their homonym partners. Switch crowns and play again and again. Later, students may work in partners or individually to make a class book of homonyms similar to *You, Yew and Ewe Are Homonyms, Too*.
