

BASEBALL Lesson Plans

Dear Parents and Educators,

These lesson plans are designed as follow up activities based on the springtime theme. Feel free to expand on the lessons, and be creative! Remember, the point of doing a lesson is to convey information in a way that will help your children/students understand and retain the material presented.

Lesson #1 Categories:

Using the baseball book, find out how many items are clothes versus how many items are baseball items that are not clothes.

Follow up questions: What items are special just for baseball? Is a baseball glove “clothes”? What else can you wear that would be special for baseball? Do other sports have similar items to wear? Why or why not?

Lesson #2 Safety:

Using the baseball book, find out what items are used for safety.

Follow up questions: What part of the body does each item protect? What else can a person wear to keep themselves safe when playing baseball? Why is proper safety equipment important?

Lesson #3 Vocabulary:

Using the printable baseball book worksheets, have your students match the baseball pictures. Then, have your students use the printable icons to cut and paste a word web. Be creative and have students use pictures from a newspaper sports section to add pictures and words to their word web.
