On Saint Patrick's Day, we remember Saint Patrick.






On Saint Patrick's Day, we celebrate Irish heritage.



There are many foods we eat on Saint Patrick's Day. Irish soda bread is a traditional Saint Patrick's Day food.






Colcannon is another Saint Patrick's Day food. It is made from potatoes, meat and cabbage.
